"Winning a Moonbeam is particularly meaningful to me because of the award's special focus on inspiration, emotional literacy and compassion," says Austin. "In writing 'Cuddles,' my hope was to show kids how important a simple gesture like a cuddle is for connecting with our friends and loved ones, and to explain that, depending on the context in which it's given and received, a hug can say many different, complex, and important things."
